



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) made and entered into on the date 20 July, 2022 and signed by the following parties:

- A. SRI GURU GOBIND SINGH COLLEGE, Patna City, expression of which shall mean and include its successors in interest and assigns of the first part (hereinafter referred to as SGGSC), and
- B. HERITAGE SOCIETY, Patna, expression of which shall mean and include its successors in interest and assigns of the second part (hereinafter referred to as HS).

PREAMBLE

Sri Guru Gobind Singh College (SGGSC) is a Minority-cum-Constituent Unit of Patliputra University. It is a co-educational institution, situated on the bank of holy Ganga River and in vicinity of the holy shrine of Takht Sri Harmandarjee Patna Saheb. The college is associated with the cherished and revered name of 'Badshah Darvesh Sri Guru Gobind Singh Jee- who born in this holy and historic city Patna Saheb on 22nd December, 1666. This light of patriotism and sacrifice, essentially eternal in character, will never die out, rather it will continue to shine over our murky national horizon and will root out the social and Political evils for which this great luminary stood and fought for the whole life. The college is easily accessible and well connected to airport and various railway stations of Patna. Owing to the growing needs of the education and heritage of academic distinctions, SGGSC has become one of the most sought-after colleges in Patna City. PURPOSE and MODALITIES

In order to achieve the goal of inclusive education, it is necessary for SGGSC and HS to act in convergent manner within the purview of their respective statutory provisions by sharing the academic resources and expertise available with both the parties, herewith SGGSC and HS sign this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to cooperate and jointly work in the following general agreements:

 Maximum and Sustainable use and utilization of available academic resources with both the parties, to conduct joint programmes of research, extension and training in such a synchronized manner that each of the party entering into agreement gets maximum advantage from their mandated objectives as well as for synergizing existing academic courses, research, extension and training programmes and schemes.

RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT

The faculty, officers, research staff of SGGSC and its Centres and HS and its
regional Centres of either party if needed, may take part in teaching, research,
research guidance, extension and training activities in an academic session, as
worked out and as per specialization and for the benefit of students, topics of

- Faculty, officers, Research staff of either/or both parties, may apply for joint collaborative research projects. Data generated and /or publications through such collaborative research could be published in joint authorship / joint copyright.
- Undertaking Research Studies, Collaborative research programme, Study Exchange programme as per respective mandate and objectives of both parties would be taken up by the Faculty, officers, and Research staff.
- Both the parties would cooperate and encourage sharing of experience, scientific knowledge, and technology advances, and its dissemination or expansion in communities/societies.
- All research materials used in the collaboration will be transferred using Material Transfer Agreements (MTAs). Either party may use such materials, but will give due credit to the source of the materials.

DURATION, TERMINATION AND RENEWAL

- This MOU will be initially effective for the period of 5 years from the date entering into it.
- Notwithstanding anything contained in the MoU, the confidentiality and sociality of any research data or otherwise shall not supersede the Acts, Rules and by Laws of respective Institutions entering upon the MoU.
- This memorandum of understanding may be amended or terminated at any time by either party provided that notice of termination or amendment is given by the notifying party to the other party before thirty (30) days of the date on which the termination or the amendments is intended to become effective.
- However, the commitments, made before the date of termination of the MoU, will continue to be operative till the academic session is over.
